CAN DEBT CONSOLIDATION

Save You Money?

Many agree we are living in uncertain times that can bring about unprecedented financial debt. As store charges, credit card bills, and even medical bills start to come in, it may be hard to keep track of all those due dates. Financially, it can be frustrating making small payments towards all balances and never seeing any progress. It's in this case that you may consider a debt consolidation loan.



Debt consolidation loans are designed to be used to combine unsecured loans and bills together into one loan. Often, the payment is less than the combined minimum payments of the loans and cards individually, but pays down the debt as a whole much faster.

Here's an example:

	Total Owed	Monthly Payment	Months To Pay Off
Credit Card 1	\$1,200.00	\$25.00	86
Credit Card 2	\$750.00	\$25.00	43
Credit Card 3	\$550.00	\$25.00	29
Furniture Store Payment	\$2,300.00	\$80.00	42
Doctor Bill	\$3,000.00	\$200.00	17
Total	\$7,800.00	\$355.00	

With a consolidation loan, all debts to be paid would be totaled up into one loan, with one payment. In our example, a \$7,800 consolidation loan at 10.00% APR for 36 months would have a monthly payment of approximately \$252. In this example, that's a monthly payment savings of \$100 to give you breathing room. Another option would be to pay that extra \$100 towards your loan and pay off the loan almost a year early!

Things To Consider

The point of a consolidation loan is to pay down debt with one easy monthly payment over a set period of time. However, if debt builds up again while the loan is being paid off, you could end up in worse financial trouble. But, we are here to help you navigate these tough situations.

A good idea would be to talk with a loan officer at the credit union. They can help you review your individual situation in detail, and discuss all options that may be available to you.
